# HOW TO APPLY

1. Complete the Application for Undergraduate Admission and Scholarship ([udayton.edu/apply](http://udayton.edu/apply)) or the Common Application ([commonapp.org](http://commonapp.org)).
2. Submit official transcripts from all high schools and colleges you've attended, even if it wasn't recent. To be considered official, transcripts must come directly from the institution(s) you attended in a sealed envelope.
3. If you are under 21 years old, have your ACT or SAT results sent to the admission and financial aid office at the address listed below.
